MEASUREMENT: (1) All boats shall have a valid Measurement Data Sheet on file with SCIRA and are subject to measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the SCIRA Representative, or Race Committee. (2) All boats are required to have a current Class decal properly displayed.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The regatta Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration desk when registration opens.

COURSES: The courses will be “variant” per SCIRA *Rules for Conducting Sanctioned Regattas*.

SCORING: The Low Point System of Appendix A4 will apply. One race shall be completed to constitute a regatta; all races will be scored. This changes RRS A2.
