#### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

## 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Participation in the AYC Open Regatta is open to all boats of the Thistle, Y-Flyer, Snipe, and Laser Classes. Additionally, participation will be open to any centerboard dinghy class with an LOA less than or equal to 20' that can register three or more participating boats (excluding late registration.) Fleet officers or class representatives wishing to register an additional class should contact the Regatta Chair for more information.
