Notice of Race

1 Rules

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in the current version of *The Racing Rules of Sailing For 2021-2024.*

2 Sailing Instructions

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after March 4th online at <u>https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/super_saturday</u>.

3 Communication

3.1 The online official notice board is located at <u>https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/super_saturday</u>.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Laser / ILCA and Opti classes.
- 4.2 All Laser / ILCA rigs are allowed. A minimum of three entries of the same rig constitutes a fleet.
- 4.3 Class legal sails are not required.
- 4.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee by end of day Wednesday, March 6th.
- 4.5 Boats may enter the event by registering online at <u>https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/super_saturday</u>.
- 4.6 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 Fees

5.1 The entry fee is \$15 per boat. Online payment and credit card options are available. Cash and Checks will also be accepted (payable to Laser Fleet 116). Venmo to @Scott-Barnas. Zelle to scottbarnas1@gmail.com.

6 Schedule

- 6.1 Saturday, March 9
 - 0930 Registration open in the clubhouse
 - 1030 Registration closed
 - 1100 Skipper's Meeting at the Point Viewing Pavilion Lunch (on your own, not provided)
 - 1157 Warning signal for first race. More races to follow. We will try for six races. No races will start after 1600. Post-race refreshments, socializing, and awards at the Point Viewing Pavilion.

7 Scoring

- 7.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores (no throw-outs).

8 Acceptance of Risk, Waiver of Liability, and Indemnification

8.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing Authority will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

9 Prizes

- 9.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
 - 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes for each fleet consisting of 7 or more boats, or
 - 1st and 2nd place prizes for each fleet consisting of 4 6 boats, or
 - 1st place prize for each fleet consisting of 3 boats

10 Further Information

- 10.1 All Sailors shall be required to wear a Coast Guard approved life jacket while on the water. Wet/dry suits are strongly recommended due to cold water temperatures in March on Lake Allatoona.
- 10.2 AYC prohibits pets in restricted areas, firearms, and motorcycles on club premises.
- 10.3 It is the responsibility of AYC members/guests to take appropriate measures to safeguard their personal property while on club premises.
- 10.4 Club Gate will be set on automatic open Friday afternoon. Pull up close to gate to trigger opening. A guest code will be provided to visiting competitors Saturday morning and will open the gate from 9am to 4pm. Please text Scott Barnas at 770.990.4179 to get code.
- 10.5 Camping and showers are available free at AYC.
- 10.6 Hotels are just 5 minutes away located at I-75 and Highway 92.
