You are officially registered for Junior Week 2022. Get ready for a fun week! Junior Week is run all by volunteers. Camp dates are Sunday, June 12<sup>th</sup> to Friday June 17<sup>th</sup>. You might be asking what I can do to step up to make Junior Week 2022 be extra ordinary. Well campers, you come with the spirit of knowing *“Good Vibes”* matter. Parents, we need you to volunteer, so be on the lookout for a sign up genius. (Required 4 hours per camper)

Our theme for Junior Week 2022 is *“Go With The Flow”*. This means go with what comes in the moment. When the wind blows our way, we are along for the ride. Here are some details to know and talk about with your family before coming to Jr Week. Our number one concern is safety. The Garrett and Warnken team will be going over expectations at registration. Morning check-in for all campers will be at 7:45am at flagpole for coaches’ roll call. Campers are then turned over to cabin parent at 5:00pm. Junior Week curfew is 10:00. Please bring a comfortable life jacket with a whistle. Your life jacket must be worn while on docks and boats. Shoes are a big deal; they need to be worn on all docks. No flipflops, shoes need to be a sailing shoe or strap-on sandals such as Chacos or Tevas. Sunscreen, sunscreen, sunscreen! And drinking water is so important in staying healthy. Of course, so is getting some sleep, so don’t forget your comfortable pillow and maybe ear plugs. We want everyone leaving Junior Week with fun memories to share for years to come.

***What about boats?*** If you are using AYC boats such as Opti or 420, you are responsible for taking care of that boat and sailing gear all week long. All laser sailors, bring your own boat ready to sail with all rigging and parts. All laser sailors need to be checked off by Adrienne. Ed Marks is ready to help with Laser rigging and parts on Memorial Day, Sunday, May 30<sup>th</sup> at 8:00am. If you need an AYC 4.7 laser rig, you need to sign up with Adrienne if you did not when you registered. It is first come first get.

***What sailing group am I in?*** The coaches will be announcing sailing groups on Sunday. When you registered for Junior Week, you signed up for boat type and sailing level. All sailors will be divided into Optis, 420s or Lasers. All groups will be divided into two groups by sailing level with exception of 420s. 420s will have two groups that be a mix of sailing levels.

***What cabin will I be in?*** Pick up cabin assignment and cabin map at the clubhouse then head to your cabin to start registration.

- 2:00** Cabin Parents meet campers, give out camp t-shirt, go over rules and do a get to know you game.
- Campers put on swimsuit for swim test & beach swimming and put camp t-shirt on over swimsuit for camp group picture at 3:45.
  - Bring a towel
- 2:45** All parents, campers, cabin parents, coaches, medics come to clubhouse for Jr. Week Kick off meeting.
- After meeting parents are welcome to go or come down to beach for swimming.
- 3:45** Jr. Week Camp Group Picture with camp shirts on at front of clubhouse.
- 4:00** Camper's whose names were called for swim test go with Clint to swim test. Swim test will be at 3<sup>rd</sup> dock. (when finished with swim test come to beach check in with cabin parent)
- All other campers go to your cabin parent and walk down together to beach. You can swim if cabin parent is there.
